

## Cards for All Occasions

### Valentine's Day Card

To create this card we used the following:

- Flat Red, 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" Fold Over Card
- Medium Happy Valentine's Day Template
- Medium Cupid Heart Template
- Medium Heart Chain Template
- Large Alphabet Calligraphy-Upper Case Template
- Large Alphabet Calligraphy-Lower Case Template
- Ultra-Fine Crystal Glitter
- Small Align-a-Card



Lay Happy Valentine's Day upside down on top of an align-a-card on the light source. Trace the outline of the template to make a frame. Then emboss the inside. Trace cupid on card as shown, outlining the template first, and then embossing the inside. To make the double hearts use your Heart Chain. Do the largest heart on the chain, then the 3rd heart on the chain inside of the first heart. Overlap another heart done in the same way. It is best to emboss the top heart in the overlap first, stopping at the edge of the first heart. Personalize using the Alphabet. Remember to work backwards, and place your template upside down on your light source. Use the three smallest hearts of the chain to fill in. Use a glue pen add glitter to the outer hearts in the overlapping hearts, the wings of cupid, and some of the small hearts.

### Felt Kissing Fish

#### Supplies:

- Red and white felt
- 18 inch piece of yarn or ribbon
- Scissors
- Glue



#### Directions:

1. Cut hearts in each of the following sizes:  
 Extra large for the body (2 in each color)  
 Large for the tail (1 in each color)  
 Medium for the fins (2 in each color)  
 Medium for the mouth (1 in each color)  
 Small for the eyes (2 in each color)
2. Lay 1 extra large white heart on the table in front of you.
3. Glue 1 end of the yarn or ribbon to the center of the heart.
4. Glue 1 medium red heart to the dip in the heart to make the lips, and 1 large red heart to the point of the heart to make the tail. (See the picture.) Make sure the red hearts extend past the ends of the extra large white heart.
5. Cover the white heart with a thin layer of glue and glue on the other extra large white heart.
6. Glue red eyes and fins to each side of the fish.
7. Repeat steps 2 through 6 to make another fish in the opposite colors (start with the extra large red heart and add white hearts.)
8. Let dry and hang as a Valentine's Day decoration.

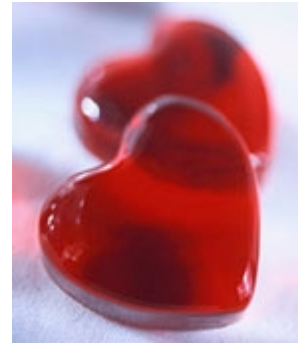

### Heart Jell-O® Blocks

- 2 large boxes of red or pink Jell-O® (sugar free or regular)
- 1 box (4 packets) of Knox gelatin
- 5 cups boiling water
- Heart shaped cookie cutters



Mix dry Jell-O® and Knox gelatin in bowl. Add boiling water. Mix until dissolved. Spray jelly roll pan with cooking spray and place in the refrigerator. Pour Jell-O® mix into the pan while it is in the refrigerator. Let set 3 hours, or until firm. Let kids use heart shaped cookie cutters to cut out the Jell-O® blocks. Enjoy for Valentine's Day!

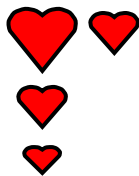
